



The Ethical Dilemma of Abortion

Abortion issues have been a key focus of Republicans - often a determining factor for their vote. They treat it as a Christian issue.

But did you know:

- There is not one verse in the Bible about abortion. None.
- Christians sometimes refer to verses about the sanctity of life. These Christians might be concerned about the life of the fetus, but are usually for Capital Punishment and hawkish about war. They are against social programs that help women and families cope with another child.
- Hillary Clinton wants abortion to be "safe, legal, and rare." She believes in educating the public about reproductive health, about how to prevent unsafe and unwanted pregnancies.
- There is a Pro-Life group within the Democratic Party called Democrats for Life. They believe in programs that truly help reduce abortions - education, contraceptives, family planning. They believe in a Consistent Life Ethic - against abortion, against war, against capital punishment, and supportive of programs to help families.
- Abortions are lower under Pro-Choice presidents and a Pro-Choice Congress.
- Abortions are lower in countries and states where abortion is legal.
- Pro-Life stances do not reduce or eliminate abortions. If Roe vs. Wade were repealed, chances are there would be more abortions.
- Abortion is an ethical issue. Hillary Clinton respects the dilemma - and is willing to engage those with a Pro-Life stance to truly help reduce abortions - and to be effective.
