



The Woman Card

Did you know that:

Jesus was one of the first to break sexist stereotypes?

- He talked to the woman at the well in Samaria. So what? It's important, because men didn't talk to women, and especially a known adulteress, (7 husbands - and not all of them "husbands"). Jews hated Samaritans, but he treated her with respect - for her and for her intelligence. It shocked his disciples.
- Women, including Mary Magdalene, traveled around the countryside with Jesus and his 12 apostles. They provided the means for his ministry.
- Jesus respected Mary, Martha's sister, who listened and talked to him, even though she wasn't doing the serving role of her sister, Martha. "She has chosen the better part," said Jesus. Having a dialogue between men and women was almost unheard of.
- Mary Magdalene continued Jesus' message after His death and was one of his most influential followers and evangelists.
- Women were the first who testified that Jesus had risen. He first appeared, in His resurrected state, to Mary Magdalene. She's the one who told the other disciples.

A Christian needs to play the Woman Card - for equal rights and equal respect to women.
